### Approval of Agenda

### **Study Programme Reports**

- DIM (presented by HoSP Vasilis Galis):
  - 2024 action plans:
    - Focus on specialization changes, alignment with GBI, and increased programme flexibility.
    - Teacher seminar prioritizing well-being.
    - Minor revisions to ILOs and focus on ChatGPT.
    - Staffing reorganization and improved hiring processes.
    - Slight decline observed in course evaluations.
  - o 2025 focus areas:
    - Emphasis on AI and preparation for 2025 Programme Review.
    - Address syllabus overlaps between GBI and DIM, as well as improving group dynamics.
    - Suggestions for dividing group work between GBI and new students face challenges due to non-participation.

# • Student Comments:

- Weekly overlaps between GBI and DIM create frustration, particularly for former GBI students in group work.
- DIM students sometimes dominate group dynamics.
- Overlapping content (syllabus and chapters) between the two programmes is seen as unproductive.
- Suggestions included clearer programme distinctions and pathways.

# • GBI (presented by HoSP Hanne Westh Nicolajsen):

- **2024** key points:
  - Challenges around AI and dependence on part-time lecturers.

- Efforts to enhance course coherence and engagement, including exercise classes.
- Successfully hired new resources and teachers, benefitting both GBI and DIM.
- Strengthened international partnerships for student exchanges.
- o 2025 focus areas:
  - Continued effort to decrease reliance on external lecturers; ongoing hiring process.
  - Implementation of revised GBI curriculum, including new electives such as business analytics.
  - Expectation management and improved communication about overlaps with DIM.

# • Student Comments:

- Frustration among GBI students regarding overlaps and repetitiveness in the first semester of DIM.
- Suggestions for more innovative electives, such as quantitative methods and software-focused courses.
- Concerns over low attendance at exercise classes for both GBI and DIM students, which affects group work dynamics.
- Positive feedback on new exchange locations and the revised GBI programme.
