GBI

- Sisse is working on offering new electives at GBI and implementing the Managing Risk in IT and Cybersecurity summer course will be offered in autumn in a slightly different version. Sisse is coordinating with DIM to make sure the courses offered do not overlap and match in level according to which courses you take when.
- A health IT-related elective is being developed for spring 2027.
- Students going on exchange have a hard time finding substitute courses for Sustainable IT.
 - A solution in agreement with the course manager has been made where students do self-study with recorded lectures and material accessible in LearnIT.
 - Sisse is also looking into finding student ambassadors among GBI students who have previously been on exchange. This way students know what they are getting into before they apply for exchange and can ask about course selection and level of courses at the universities they are planning on attending.

DIM
