- **Workshop on python, machine learning, and pipeline fundamentals**

Matas (BUILD Lab manager) visited SATBUSS to present workshop offers from BUILD Lab to students who want to improve their qualifications for Python programming

Workshops will be arranged to help out the students. Waiting for confirmation on dates, but expected to be in week 34.

Matas is very interested in alignment between courses with programming subjects on both GBI and DIM and would like to reach out to the heads of programmes for GBI and DIM to talk about this.

Sisse suggests having Matas visit the semester meetings with GBI students. Starting in autumn 2026.

Comment from students at DIM: It is difficult for the students to have introduction to programming parallel with AI processes, because the students need to use skills they learn in programming in AI processes.

- There used to be alignment focus between these types of courses and in collaboration with Study Lab as well, but right now we do not know whether this alignment is still ongoing.

How do we reach the students and let them know that there are workshops for them?

- Let the students know before they need to register for courses in Autumn 2026 in June. Go to the lectures and tell the students directly about this offer.
