This is the last SAT CS meeting in 2025 – thank you to all members especially the student representatives who have provided valuable feedback from peers and raised relevant items across CS programmes for SAT CS to discuss.

Meeting structure

General feedback about SAT CS meetings from the student representatives:

SAT CS should mainly discuss items that are relevant across all CS programmes and not programme specific things which for other representatives are a waste of time.

SAT CS should consider restructuring and have fewer but longer meetings with items across programmes. But also plan programme specific meetings to discuss programme items.

SAT agreed at the beginning of the year to discuss the cross items in SAT and talk about the specific items between HoP and students from the same programme.

Spring 2026 meetings: As a pilot SAT CS will meet less often but longer in relation to the annual wheel of education. Study programme reports, evaluations ect.

Generative AI discussion

Some students are claiming that ITU have a reputation of not being on time with generative AI in teaching.

HoPs are wondering whether it is the students' experience that ITU is lacking behind?

It is not the experience that ITU is old fashion or lacking behind.

The DS students have not experienced GenAI as banned in courses. In relation to exams and as a student you experience some grey areas around exams, and you must consider how to use GenAI and remember to clarify how it was used.

What about during courses?

Used it as a tool during courses and did not miss it being taught.

With the DS background we are probably also more into the use of GenAI.

Maybe allowing more AI throughout the courses – where can it fill out processes in future work life.
