1. Approval of agenda

3. Follow up on Danish Student Survey 2025

- No big issues for the GAMES programme specifically, but SAT games agreed that the points in the action plan overall are fine.
- When looking at the physical teaching environment (i.e. point 6 – Optimizing the campus) it is important to also take into consideration the specific challenges at the EHK building and not just focus on the RLV building. Indoor climate and facilitation of group facilities was mentioned as areas that could be improved at EHK.
