### Minutes:

#### 1. Approval of agenda

*The agenda was approved.*

#### 2. ITU Teaching Award

*Viktoria presented the suggested new process for the internal teaching award.*

- The suggestion is an attempt to make broader involvement in the internal teaching award with SAT looking at the first list of nominees
- Main feedback from SAT GAMES:
  - Great to have the students involved – makes a lot of sense
  - Perhaps a definition of what ITU considers “excellency in teaching” is needed.
    - - to align the process in SAT with that of the final committee
    - - to make clear, what we do *not* want to award (for instance people working too many hours.)
  - Are two steps of shortlisting needed?
  - Differing opinions regarding whether the shortlist should be public
  - Worry that the final committee might be biased toward specific didactic approaches if expanded.

#### 3. Draft of Study Programme Report

*Rune went through the draft of the study programme report.*

Main points from the discussion:

- Half the evaluation data is lacking. This gives us lower overall scores for 2026, as there was some very specific issues in spring 2026.
- The bar for employed graduates has been raised by ITU. This creates bigger issues for a smaller programme like ours and will look worse in the future with the lower intake coming.
- Completion rate used to be better. Should we worry about that our dropout rate is much higher than what it used to be?

- Women's mentorship programme was launched Friday. Very nice meeting and mentors.
- Looking forward to hearing about TAGs. So far only heard good things. Nice that TAGs were placed right at the entrance. The set-up with islands and posters was good.
