# Supervision plan and agreements

Making a supervision agreement is about aligning expectations between supervisor and student(s) and planning the process.

Early in the process, be sure to talk to each other about the practicalities of supervision (for example means of communication, meeting frequency, other obligations, need for deadlines) as well as topics closer to the actual project (for example types of supervisor input, reading and feedback). For inspiration, you can find a non-exhaustive inspiration list of topics that could be included in the agreement on <a href="ITU Student">ITU Student</a>.

Use the table below to note your alignment of expectations in as many details as you find necessary. Do not include confidential information.

Finally, add a mark for agreement from both student(s) and supervisor. Please remember that the agreement is an opportunity to frame the supervision process. It is **not** a contract, and you can discuss and amend the content at any time.

# Where to keep the supervision agreement

Keep the **Supervision Agreement** in your project folder in LearnIT. That way, it is always available to you and your supervisor.

First, make sure that you have submitted the **Project Agreement** in the project base. 24 hours after the project agreement has been **approved**, a folder with the title of your project opens in LearnIT.

How to save the supervision agreement in your LearnIT project folder:

- 1. Go to your project folder in LearnIT (the folder has the same title as your project)
- 2. Open Discussion Forum
- 3. Click "Add a new discussion topic"
- 4. Write supervision agreement in the "Subject" field
- 5. Attach the completed supervision agreement
- 6. Click "Post to forum"

If you need to change the supervision agreement, you can add a new discussion topic with an updated file.
