Marco discussed the course with course manager and will do again. The course is mandatory on KCS from next autumn, and it is important to deal with challenges now. Comments from course manager (CM):

50 students registered for the course, A little more than half of them showed up for lectures as a maximum, for exercises even less.

CM knows, workload seems huge, but the course has been restructured over spring. After the exam, course manager received reports from students that the workload showed to be worthwhile.
