Your stay abroad

Please describe your stay abroad:

My thesis partner and I traveled to Hamburg as part of our thesis project. We wrote our thesis about the biggest smart city project in Germany: The Connected Urban Twins. Our thesis had a qualitative focus and we wished to conduct interviews on-site through an ethnographic approach. We were able to conduct our interviews over a few days.

What was your initial motivation for going abroad and did your stay meet your expectations?

Since we wrote about a German project we felt it was purposeful to travel there and speak with our informants personally. Our visit went beyonc our expectations, since we were not only able to meet with our interviewees but also see their work places. For example, we saw the CityScience Lab at the Hafencity University, and we visited the workshop of the Hamburg Port Authority. This added to our perspective in the project beyond just the interviews.

Please describe what you got out of your stay, both personally and academically, and how do you expect it to contribute to your further studies?

Personally, we were able to build trust with our interview partners on another level than if we had done the interviews online. To me, it was also an opportunity to brush up on my German skills, a language I have always enjoyed. Academically, our stay was also very important. I believe it is beneficial to be in the middle of what you are studying, rather than just reading about it, observing, and doing online/phone interviews.

Firstly, we arranged our interviews by email. Then, I booked tickets (bus to Hamburg and flight home). I booked a hotel room that was close to most of our interviews.
