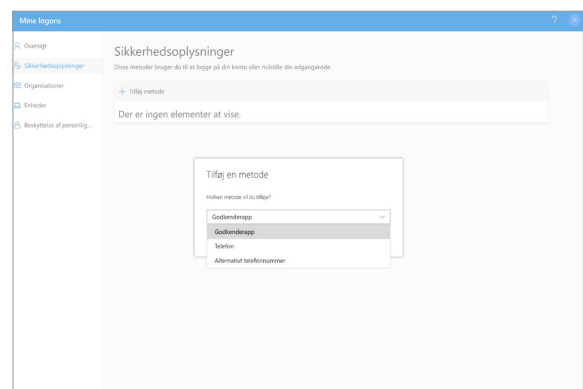
Go to go.itu.dk/mfasetup and you will meet this set-up page. Make sure you are in the 'security info' tab.

In the following we will describe how to set up authentication via mobile app and text message.



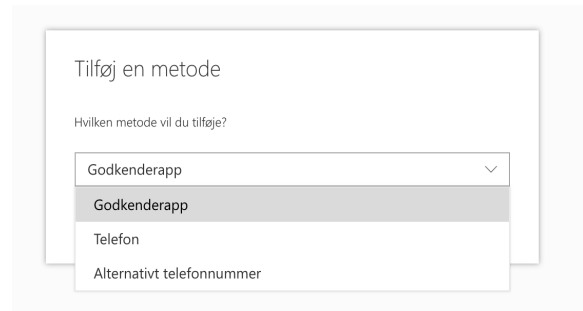

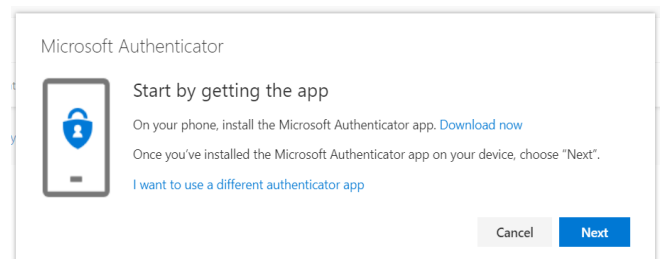
Select authentication app.

Follow the instructions to install the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device.

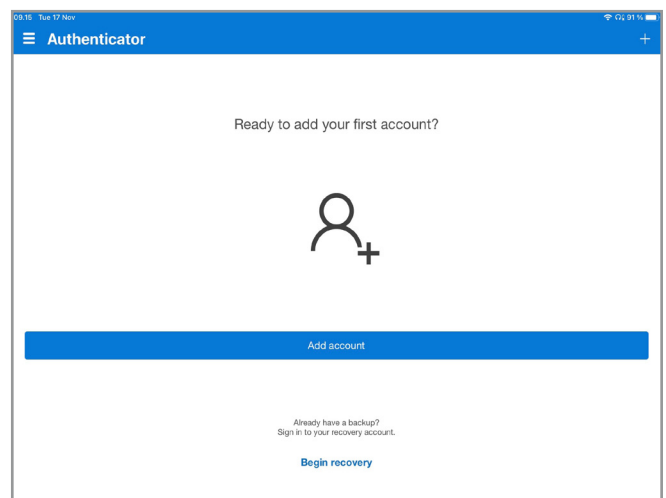
Once the app is installed, click 'next'.

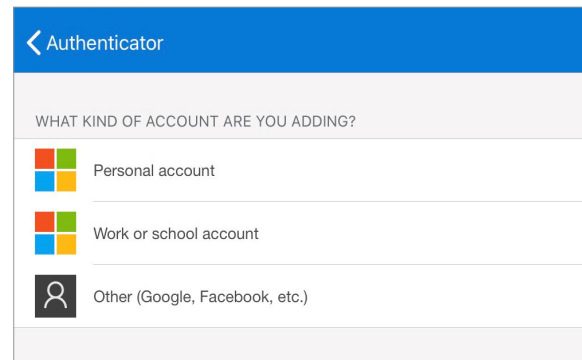
Open the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device.

Select "Add account".

Select “Work or school account”.

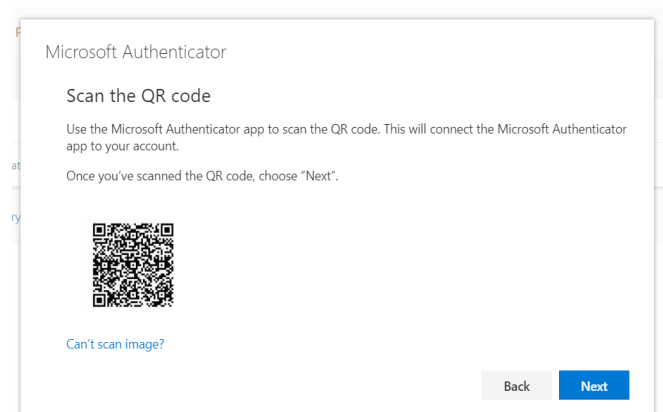

Now use the Microsoft Authenticator app to scan the QR code.

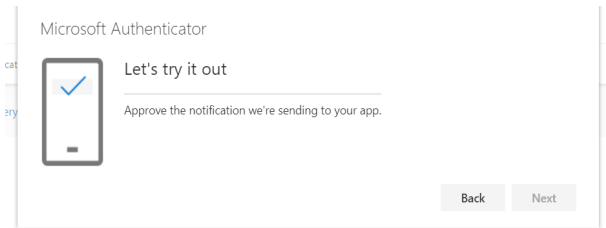
Once you have scanned it, your account should be registered in the app.

Click “Next”.

When a notification appears on your mobile device, click “Approve”.



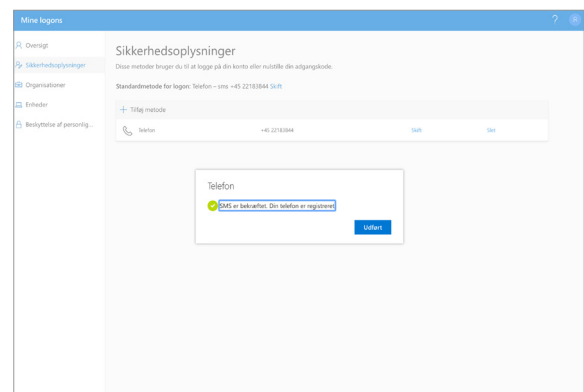
Click “Next” to finish the setup.

Please add another option for MFA now, so you aren't locked out of your account if you lose your phone.

Please continue with setup for mobile phone from 4.1.

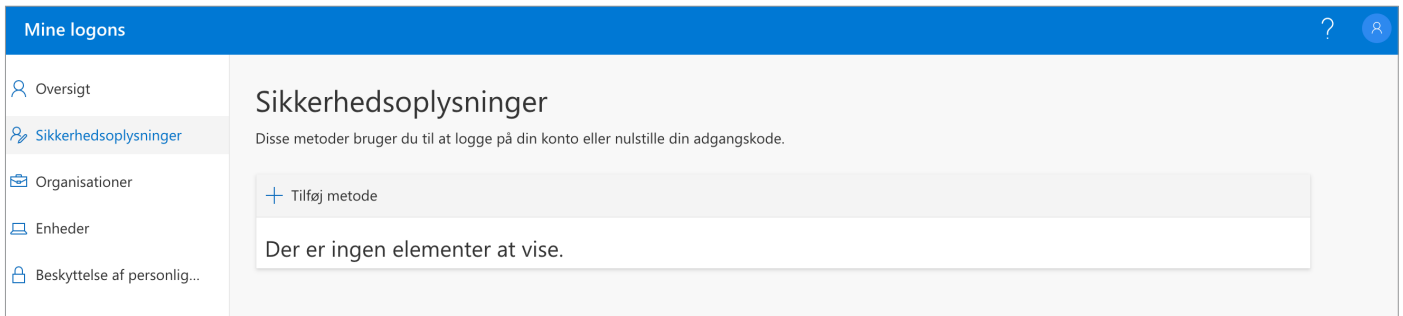

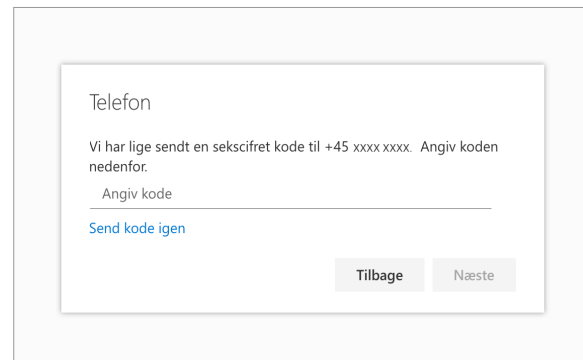
Input the phone number you want to use for authentication.
