A <u>Study Environment Assessment Action Plan</u> was approved by the Board of Studies 31 May. At that occasion, a student representative mentioned that he was a bit puzzled to find that the point about utilizing SAT members to refer students with wellbeing issues to the right information and help was left out of the action point 1.2 (Awareness on where to get help and information). The questions on when and how to involve student representatives also relates to action point 1.3 (Exclusion, bullying, harassment, and discrimination) and the discussions of these action points were somewhat overlapping when discussing and drafting the Action Plan.

For this reason, Lise has joined us to hear perspectives from student representatives on how to include the students at ITU and make them aware of how their voices can be heard through SAT and Board of Studies (BoS).

- The student representatives/active students work well as a link between the students and SAT/BoS.
- It is important to note that the students are not aware of the SATs or different Boards where subjects such as the ones in the Action Plan are discussed. We need to make the students aware of the SATs, BoS, Student Council etc.
- Make use of the public space/atrium to let the students know of the different Boards and SAT (when we get back to ITU full time)
- The diversity issue needs a bigger group of student inputs the SAT representatives do not feel comfortable representing all students on this matter
- There is still a need and a continuous demand for a new diversity officer, but even though representatives in BoS have suggested this there has not been any clear answers or action taken on this yet
