

IT Match Making is your unique opportunity for career discovery as the event allows students and employers the opportunity to spark new connections.

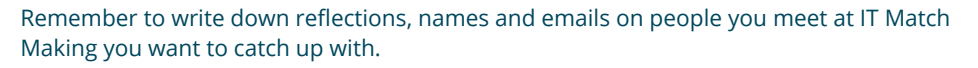
CV Picture
